








Partnerships for pathways to Higher Education and science engagement in Regional Clusters of Open Schooling

The month of August was dedicated to finalizing the Educational KIT in terms of content and design. The Educational KIT contains a description of each innovative educational methodology and how it can be implemented according to each education sector and non-formal activities based on the following innovative methodology.

-  Personalized Learning
-  Project-Based Learning (PBL)
-  Place-Based Education
-  Real-World Learning

The Educational KIT will support the consortium in providing quality and validated formative activities, generating further impact on the local communities in terms of improvement of the teaching and learning process.

Each partner created 4 activities based on the previously mentioned methodologies, all using the formative assessment type of evaluation, targeting their specific target group:

- Deses-3 association – youth
- University of Valladolid – university students
- E-SCHOOL Educational Group – adult learners
- DDE Karditsas – pupils



During the following months of our project the Educational KIT will be implemented during a training for teachers, who will later on implement the activities with their pupils. This process will help us to get feedback on the Educational KIT, in order to be able to ensure a qualitative and useful educational resource for professionals and learners.
